

Please pass on my sincere thanks to the review Panel for their thorough and thoughtful comments.

I have one correction to make, which is that the Reporting Period for the Greenpeace International report was 1 Jan-31 Dec 2010 (not 2009 as is stated in the "Note on accountability report" for GPI).

We very much appreciated the panel's advice in the cover letter from the panel, that there are three options for how we approach reporting in future as a global organisation with national affiliated organisations. We will be looking at these options in the coming months to determine which we will choose in future. There will inevitably be a tradeoff between the comprehensiveness of a global consolidated report and the level of detail that can be provided (at least for some of our national/regional offices) by separate national reporting, particularly in the case of indicators that we do not consider as being of high priority or relevance for Greenpeace to track and report on a worldwide basis.

In a few instances, information is missing or incomplete because of the timing of this report. For Greenpeace, which operates its global accounting on the calendar year, a submission date of February is too early to provide the final consolidated global figures for income and expenditure. A more flexible timing for submission of these reports would allow for an improvement in the quality of the information: in essence this would allow a synchronisation between reporting to the Accountability Charter and the publication of our Annual report.
