## **Our department**

- The international advocacy department
- Fully accessible office in Brussels
- 7 out of 8 members of staff are persons with disabilities
- Reasonable accommodation enables staff to work on an equal basis
- Department are leaders in diversity and non-discrimination

#### Social inclusion - who?



- Often referred to as 'most marginalised' groups such as:
- Persons with disabilities
- Indigenous people
- Women and children
- People living with HIV/AIDs
- Refugees

## **Guiding principles**



The UN Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities as the basis of our work

## **Principles:**

 Respect for inherent dignity, individual autonomy including the freedom to make one's own choices, and independence of persons;

## **Guiding principles**



- Non-discrimination;
- Full and effective participation and inclusion in society;
- Respect for difference and acceptance of persons with disabilities as part of human diversity and humanity;
- Equality of opportunity; Accessibility;
- Equality between men and women;
- Respect for the evolving capacities of children with disabilities



#### **Inclusion - how?**

- Adapting systems: organisational mainstreaming
- Addressing barriers to accessibility
- Accessible environments
- Accessible training
- Participation of excluded groups
- Inclusion and HR policies
- Inclusive programmes, research, M&E

#### **CBM** practices



- IAA department attitudes, built environment, recruitment, reasonable accommodation
- IT & comms: website, software, publications
- Programmes: voice and participation a key strategic objective of CBM; inclusive policies and programmes
- Training: assessment centre
